

# Crane Mountain Enhancement Incorporated Environmental Education Grant



Crane Mountain Enhancement Incorporated (CMEI) is an organization responsible for monitoring the operations of the Crane Mountain Landfill and acting as a liaison with the surrounding community.

The \$2,000 CMEI Environmental Education Grant is awarded to students who have demonstrated a commitment to environmental issues and sustainable living. Applicants must be graduating from high school and entering their first year of study in an approved post-secondary program. Applicants must also live within the host community of the Crane Mountain Landfill which runs from the South Bay Bridge along the River Road (South Bay, Ketepec, Belmont, Morna, Martinon) through Grand Bay-Westfield to the Nerepis Bridge.
